If technical issues arise, we will post bulletins at <u>jasna.org/conferences-events/agms/agm-updates</u>. This Guide provides a preview of the screens in the AGM registration system. You can use it, along with the AGM webpages that branch off the index page at <u>https://jasna.org/agms/victoria/home.php</u>, to decide on your selections before logging on to register. The registration system times out after 20 minutes of inactivity, so advance preparation is a good idea.

If this is your first time using our online registration system, please be sure to <u>read the complete</u> guidance on the registration webpage at <u>https://jasna.org/agms/victoria/registration.php</u>.

Once you begin registering, carry on! If you find you're missing some of the required information or have a question, go ahead and finish registering and we'll help you make corrections later. If you have payment difficulties, choose "payment by check" and complete your registration.

Don't panic! The forms are long, but the process itself is simple. The online screens and fields match this Registration Guide, so if you use this Guide to prepare, all you have to do is transfer your selections to the online system.

The #1 problem people encounter is inability to proceed after clicking "Next." This is usually because a required field has not been filled in. If this happens, go back through the page and look for a message in very small red type beneath a question or selection telling you that a response is required. All required fields are marked with red asterisks.

Registration Steps

The following are the steps for Attendee registration. Companions will not see options for Breakout Speaker selections and do not need to state that they are JASNA members.

1. START ON THE JASNA REGISTRATION PAGE.

When you're ready to register, go to the <u>registration webpage</u> and click on the REGISTER NOW button. This will take you from the JASNA website into the registration system.



2. FIRST REGISTRATION SYSTEM SCREEN.

Click on either of the REGISTER NOW buttons, at top or bottom of the screen.



3. REGISTRATION TYPE.

This page collects lots of information: your contact information, emergency contact name and phone number, JASNA membership information, AGM meal selections, and information on support needs. Then, you will be asked to acknowledge the Terms and Conditions for attending the AGM, acknowledge understanding of COVID-19 policies, and answer questions about your vaccination status.

The JASNA Membership section asks you to:

- State whether you are a JASNA Member in good standing
- Indicate your primary JASNA Region (Companions can leave this blank)
- Indicate if you are a first-time attendee, new member (within 2 years), Life Member, speaker at this AGM, Regional Coordinator, or JASNA Board of Directors member (not regional board). You may select as many as apply.
- Grant or withhold permission for your name, city, and state to be printed in an Attendees List.
- Grant or withhold permission for Regional Coordinator(s) to receive your contact information for the purpose of potentially organizing a Regional gathering at the AGM.
